Programme Objectives: (National Housing Code)

Key objective is to facilitate the structured in-situ upgrading of informal settlements as opposed to relocation to achieve the following policy objectives:

Tenure Security – enhance the concept of citizenship, incorporating both rights and obligations, by recognising and formalising the tenure rights of residents within informal settlements


Health and Security – promote the development of healthy and secure living environments by facilitating the provision of affordable and sustainable basic municipal engineering infrastructure to the residents of informal settlements. This must allow for scaling up in the future

Empowerment – address social and economic exclusion by focusing on community empowerment and the promotion of social and economic integration. Building social capital through participative processes and addressing the broader social needs of communities
