

PROJECT DESCRIPTION	Voortrekker Road is a corridor development along Voortrekker Road in the City of Cape Town. The Project specifically excludes the development known as Belhar Phase 2 which is the subject of a separate proposal under the auspices of the Western Cape Government and Calgro M3.		
	The project selects five sites interspersed amongst the already formalised areas of Belhar and Salt River.		
	The specific aim of the project is to deliver more than 1 620 housing opportunities to augment the need for rental stock in the area.		
	Land assembly is still required for the two Pine Road properties (owned by the PGWC), and two Glenhaven properties (owned by the Athlone School for the Blind)		
	The other properties, namely the Dillon Lane sites and the Salt River Market are owned by the City of Cape Town. The Belhar development is almost complete and has a SHI in place		
MAIN ECONOMIC DRIVER(S)	Voortrekker Road forms a link between the Belville CBD and the Metro South East Corridor boundary and has a strong retail core with light industry. The area also boasts two Universities and a Technical School.		
DEVELOPMENT STATUS	Belhar (Madulamoho) is currently underway with over 50% of the units completed and occupied. The remainder of the sites still require finalisation of the town planning process and development plans for the developments to commence.
