PROCUREMENT OF A 360° VIDEO AND IMAGE CAPTURING SOLUTION FOR THE DOCUMENTING OF ON SITE ASSESSMENT OF HUMAN SETTLEMENTS PROJECTS

Terms of Reference

1. Introduction

- 1.1. The Housing Development Agency (HDA) is positioning itself into an effective public sector human settlements development agency. It acts as the project developer of sustainable, integrated human settlements on behalf of government to drive delivery, undertaking the following functions:
 - Accessing land for human settlements projects
 - Packaging of human settlements projects
 - Establishing delivery partnerships with the private sector
 - Mobilising, coordinating and investing funds on behalf of the public sector
 - Facilitating the resolution of blockages
 - Monitoring the implementation of human settlements projects
- 1.2. Regular site visits form part of the monitoring and evaluation process with respect to determining status of land and human settlements projects
- 1.3. The information gathered from on-site evaluations will be documented and presented in the form of reports, infographics and video blogs (vlogs). The advent of the digital age makes videos an effective tool for attracting and engaging audiences, potential partners and stake holders around human settlement issues as well as tracking progress.
- 1.4. A 360° video and image capturing solution will be one of the tools used to generate images and videos and potentially live streaming in collaboration with our Communication Unit.

2. Purpose

2.1. The HDA seeks an experienced and qualified vendor to provide a 360° video and image capturing solutions including training services and maintenance support.

3. Technical Requirements

3.1. The solution should have the following basic elements:

- Easy to edit and share images and videos to laptops for e.g. USB
- Easy to connect to video output devices for e.g. HDMI output
- On board memory for storage of images (at least 100) and videos (at least 10 minutes)
- Support of various images and videos formats (raw and compressed)
- Advanced shooting modes
- Built-in Wi-Fi connectivity, optional 3G/4G connectivity
- Compatible with Windows, iOS and Android operating systems
- Preferably 4K resolution
- Backup to cloud option
- Geo tagging option
- Microphone port option
- Water, dust and shock resistance
- Easy to mount and hand carry
- Extended battery life and conserve battery power option

4. Scope of services

- 4.1. The appointed vendor is to provide training services to selected HDA staff members over three sessions.
- 4.2. The appointed vendor is to provide hardware warranty for at least two years with the option of extending to 5 years.

5. Evaluation criteria

- 5.1. In order to facilitate a transparent selection process that allows equal opportunity to all production companies, the HDA has a policy for the appointment of consultants that will be adhered to. Proposals will be evaluated in terms of the prevailing supply chain policy applicable to the HDA. It should be noted that proposals will be assessed using the 80: 20 formula for Price and B-BBEE as per the PPPFA.
- 5.2. The HDA needs to be satisfied, in all respects, that the organisation/individual selected has the necessary resources, qualifications and abilities for this project, and that all submissions are regarded in a fair manner in terms of evaluation criteria and process.

- 5.3. The general methodology of selection will be based on quotations that will first be evaluated on their technical ability to perform the task. Any quotations scoring below 75% of the points noted in the table below will be disqualified for the second evaluation.
- 5.4. The second evaluation of technically competent quotations will be evaluated against Price and B-BBEE using a 80/20 Price/B-BBEE formula.
 - Quotations will be evaluated using the 80/20 point system, where 80 points are for functionality and price and 20 points for empowerment of historically disadvantaged individuals.
 - The following are the key criteria that will be taken into account by the HDA:
