TERMS OF REFERENCE

Electrical works and installation of prepaid electrical meter boxes on Erf 4061, Hout Bay, Western Cape RFQ/CPT/2023/010

1. INTRODUCTION

The Housing Development Agency (HDA) is a national public development agency which promotes sustainable communities by making well located and appropriately planned land available for the development of human settlement. As its primary activity, the HDA identifies, acquires, holds, develops and releases state, private as well as communal land for development. As part of its processes, the HDA conducts property holding plans in order to identify and implement services and maintenance requirements to ensure the sustainability of the properties in position.

2. BACKGROUND

The Housing Development Agency (Land Holding) is currently managing a property located on Erf 4061 Hout Bay, on behalf of the Western Cape Provincial Department of Human Settlements (WCPDHS). The property is located adjacent to the Imizamo Yethu Informal settlement.

The premises comprise of four (4) residential units. The HDA has entered into lease agreements with various tenants occupying these units on erf 4061. Currently one of the units is not energized due to a faulty electrical panel. Therefore, a service provider is needed to assess and repair the panel, facilitate the application to City of Cape Town municipality and the installation of prepaid electrical meters.

2.1. Physical Location

The properties are located on 93 Main Road in the formally developed middle to high income area of Hout Bay within the jurisdiction of City of Cape Town Metropolitan municipality, and adjacent to Imizamo Yethu informal settlements. The map on **Annexure B** provides details on the property and its location.

3. SCOPE OF SERVICES

The HDA requires from appropriately qualified, competent, experienced, and professionally registered electrical contractors to:

Conduct a status analysis of the electrical reticulation on Erf 4061.

- Submit quotations for:
 - a) Inspection and repairs of default wiring on electrical panel;
 - b) wiring & installation of a new prepaid electrical meter; and
 - c) facilitate the application (CoCT: Electricity generation and Distribution –
 Application for a new or modified electricity supply services) process with the City of Cape Town (CoCT);
 - d) Issue the electrical Certificate of Compliance (ECOC), in line with the relevant National building standard (SANS 10142 and SANS 10400), Electrical Contractors Association of South Africa (ECASA) or any other recognisable electrical regulatory body.
- The cost of all applications to be included in the price quotation.

3.1. General Requirements

- 3.1.1. The service provider shall ensure that its team has relevant expertise and have necessary equipment and support to undertake the work.
- 3.1.2. The service provider must have a qualified electrician with:
 - a) Minimum NQF level N3 national certificate for electrical engineering qualification;
 - b) Wireman's licence to issue electrical compliance certificates (ECOC);
 - c) Passed the SANS 10142-1 National Exam; and
 - d) Registered with the Department of Labour (DOL).
- 3.1.3. No upfront payment will be done. The service provider will only be paid upon completion of the scope of works.
- 3.1.4. The service provider will be expected to issue a warranty certificate on the work done.
- 3.1.5. All new material to be used shall be of approved or equal quality, colours, profiles, thickness, etc. and shall in all cases match the existing materials and shall be fixed to existing material or surfaces.
- 3.1.6. All new material to be used must be SABS approved.
- 3.1.7. The service provider will be expected to provide the electrical certificate of compliance (ECOC) in line with SANS 10142-1 at the completion of the works.

4. EXPECTED DELIVERABLES

The objective is to procure a service provider to perform electrical works on Erf 4061.

- 4.1. Tracing of wiring and installation of new wiring for the new prepaid meter boxes.
- 4.2. Fix and supply prepaid electrical meters in line with the CoCT guidelines.

- 4.3. Fix and supply material and labour for the works.
- 4.4. Make new all chasing and patching of wall due to remedial works.
- 4.5. Ensure that the DB boards are in good working condition.
- 4.6. Qualified electrician to issue an ECOC at completion of works.
- 4.7. Service provider to facilitation the process from start to finish.

Note: The above is to be read in conjunction with the Bill of Quantities as detailed in 'Annexure 1', SANS 10142-1, SANS 10400, OHS Act and any relevant standards.
